POLICIES OF SPORTS GOVERNING BODIES ON INCLUSION OF TRANSGENDER ATHLETES

This area is complex. There are a plethora of governing bodies at international, national and State levels. There are competing bodies that claim to represent or govern a sport. There are frequently differing rules in one sport depending on which body is consulted. The sports themselves have elite, professional and amateur leagues and the rules often vary between elite, professional and amateur competitions and between children and adult competitions.

NB Every effort has been made to ensure that the information is accurate but the list is not comprehensive and is subject to change as governing bodies review their policies.
